Guidebook for the 2020 Nan Ying International Folklore Festival (NYIFF)

Nan Ying International Folklore Festival has been a biennial festival since 1996. This festival is held to preserve the cultural heritage from nations around the world and to provide an opportunity for international cultural exchange. It has been one of the major cultural events in Tainan City for the past two decades. 2020 will be the 12th Anniversary of NYIFF. The festival draws more than ten thousand participants every time it is organized.

Tainan City is located in the southern part of Taiwan. It used to be the political and military center from 1624 to 1885. Since then, it has become one of the most important ancient cultural cities in Taiwan. The majority of the cultural heritages in Taiwan are located in Tainan, thus, the festival is closely bound with the historical and cultural background of Tainan City.

DATE: Oct. 1 – Oct. 10, 2020 (estimated 10 days)

VENUE: Tainan, Taiwan

1. *Main Stage - Nan Ying Green Heart Park, Tainan City (Open Air)*
2. *Tour Stage - The indoor or outdoor spaces at certain districts in Tainan City (exact venue to be confirmed)*

ORGANIZER: Cultural Affairs Bureau of Tainan City Government, Taiwan

Opening Ceremony	10/2 (Fri.)	19:30	Half of the groups will perform in the opening ceremony and the other half will perform in the closing ceremony (arranged by the Organizer). Each performance will be <u>3-5 minutes</u> long (maximum).	
Performance (Main stage or Tour stage)	10/3-9 (Sat.-Fri.)	19:30	The main stage is in Nan Ying Green Park and the tour stages are in 20 different districts. Each group should have a standard performance that lasts at least <u>20 minutes</u> long (either non-stop or with a short break in between for changing costumes).

Free Day		ALL DAY	<p>The Organizer will arrange one Free Day during the festival, and groups may choose to stay in their hotels or take a day trip around Tainan City by bus. Please note that all group members need to go <u>as one group</u> in the day trip.</p>

Closing Ceremony	10/10 (Sat.)	16:30	Same arrangement as the Opening Ceremony.

B. Organizer will provide:

➤ **Airfare Allowance**

For countries from **Asia** - **US \$2750 (tax included)** per group.

For countries from **Europe, America, Africa and Oceania** - **US \$5500 (tax included)** per group.

The Airfare Allowance will be paid in NTD cash in the meeting after the press conference. Exchange rate will be based on the cash exchange rate set by the Bank of Taiwan.

➤ **Accommodation**

Accommodation **in Tainan area** will be provided during the festival (**from Sep. 29/30 to Oct. 11/12**).

The room type will be **twin rooms** with only **1 single room** for every group. The actual number of rooms varies according to the number and gender of the group members, and the exact duration of stay is based on the arrival date of each group.

➤ **Meal**

All meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) are included from **Oct. 1 to Oct. 10**.

Group will need to afford all meals in “Free day” and the lunch of the day which the group doesn’t have “Local Life & Culture Experience.”

➤ **Guide**

Each group is assigned with **2 guides** who are responsible for assisting the groups during their stay in Taiwan (from airport pick-up to drop-off). The guides are mostly fluent in your language, and all of them can speak English.

➤ **Local Transportation**

We will provide **1 bus** for each group during the festival including airport pick-up. A truck can also be arranged to load the instruments if needed.

C. Groups are responsible for:

- International Transportation, e.g. flight tickets (booking and payment confirmation should be submitted before **July 15, 2020**)
- The Group is responsible for extra local [Taiwan area] transportation fees that don't include in the festival.
- VISA for Taiwan (if needed)
- International Travel Insurance
- International shipping/ cargo of instruments and costumes for the performance, if needed.

※Each group needs to bring a **flag** from their own country and their traditional costumes (one costume for each gender) for the audience dress-up experience.

※Groups can bring some of their traditional handicraft and unique souvenirs within the permitted scope to sell in the festival. The Organizer will offer one booth, tables and chairs.


※Groups can bring their brochures or promotional posters if needed.

D. Eligibility of Applicants

1. **All countries** and **all ages** are welcome to apply.
2. **15-30** participants per group, including administrators, group leader, dancers and musicians.
3. **Participation in the entire event** is mandatory; groups will arrive on Sep. 29 or 30, 2020 and leave on Oct. 11 or 12, 2020.
4. **Basic level of English** for email correspondence and oral communication is required. The language used during the festival will be English and Chinese.

E. Application Timeline

Application starts from now on until **Nov. 30, 2019**. Applicant must submit the following documents to nyiff.tw@gmail.com by **email or air mail**.



◆ For groups that CANNOT submit the digital copy of flight booking documents (e-ticket) before **July 15, 2020**, the Organizer reserves the right to **cancel** invitation.

F. Copyrights

1. The Organizer reserves the rights to broadcast the festival performance, either partially or entirely.
2. The groups should authorize the Organizer to use any performance photos or videos for the festival's affairs.

E. Travel / Transportation Information

Taiwan is located in East Asia, neighboring China and the Philippines, and Tainan city is in the southern part of Taiwan. There are four airports accessible for traveling to Tainan, namely, Taipei Songshan Airport (TSA), Taiwan Taoyuan International Airport (TPE), Tainan Airport (TNN) and Kaohsiung International Airport (KHH). The transportation information is as follows.


Bus
